



Permission for the Taking and Use of Photographs at Low Mill

The taking of photographs has always been an important part of a group's visit to Low Mill. They are a memory of the visit and can reflect very well the high points and the success of the visit. We have also been lucky in having access to some very good photographs that we have used for our own publicity. We would not wish to deter any of these things from happening.

However, there are Child Protection Issues associated with the taking and distribution of photographs and their uses after the event. We also have to be very careful that the pictures taken by Low Mill staff or under Low Mill staff control reflect the correct image.

Before your visit we must seek your permission to take photographs of your group members. This may have to be in line with your own school/group policy on the taking of photographs.

We ask you to sign this form granting permission and also permission to use these photographs, if they appropriate, for our own publicity. If this is not granted we will not take photographs of the group or their activities.

Any photographs taken by Low Mill staff will be downloaded and stored securely by Low Mill where they cannot be accessed by other people.
